## **PETER GRANDICH TO BE HONORED BY THE FEALGOOD FOUNDATION ON 9/11 AT TRUMP NATIONAL GOLF CLUB**

Peter Grandich's motto is simple: "To whom much is given, much is expected," and Grandich feels he's been given a whole lot more than "much." He's founder of Trinity Financial Sports & Entertainment Management Co. [[www.TrinityFSEM.com](http://www.TrinityFSEM.com)], a firm he started back in 2001 with Lee Rouson, former NY Giant and two-time Super Bowl champion. But that's just the most recent chapter in his 25-year financial career.

Dubbed the Wall Street Whiz Kid by Good Morning America in the 1980s, Grandich's career grew out of his knack for making uncannily-accurate market predictions. His ability to analyze and forecast financial happenings resulted in hundreds of media interviews including the Wall Street Journal, Barron's, New York Times, Financial News Network and dozens more. He's spoken at investment conferences around the globe and is regarded as one of the world's foremost market strategists. Grandich is also Chief Commentator of Agoracom.com, North America's largest online small-cap investment center, where tens of thousands of people follow his blog [[grandich.agoracom.com](http://grandich.agoracom.com)].

Yet, Peter will tell you the most rewarding part of his work is giving back to the community. On September 11, 2009, Grandich will be honored by the FealGood Foundation at Trump National Golf Club for his work helping 9/11 first responders.

"It's an American tragedy that has gripped my heart," says Grandich of the plight of the World Trade Center responders. "Of the 40,000 people who responded to Ground Zero after the attacks, 70 percent are sick, dying, or have already died as a result of their 9/11-related illnesses."
