In 2008, he has signed by the NY Jets. Hodge’s most memorable play came after he was signed by the Cleveland Browns in 2009. During the October 24, 2010, Browns game against the Saints, Hodges ran a fake punt for 68 yards to the Saints’ 10 yard line, completing the longest run by a punter in NFL history and the longest run by a member of the Browns all year.

Hodges has been quoted as saying he is a servant of God disguised as a punter for the Cleveland Browns.
